Pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws and the Town of Lincoln's Ordinances, this application is for the entitlement of a Senior Citizen Tax Exemption (Credit).

Lincoln's Senior Citizen's Tax Exemption ordinance is available upon request.

Please note that there shall be only one (1) Senior Citizen Exemption per qualified parcel.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must have owned and occupied property in the Town of Lincoln for a period of five (5) years or more **AND** owned and occupied your current property as of December 31 of the prior year.
2. Must have reached the age of 65 on or before December 31st of the year preceding the year in which the tax is due and payable.
3. Must apply on or before April 15th in the year this exemption is to take effect.
4. Must notify the Tax Assessor's office of any changes to ownership.
