

Total Disabled Exemption - Application

Pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws and the Town of Lincoln's Ordinances, this application is for the entitlement of a Total Disabled Tax Exemption (Credit).

Lincoln's Total Disabled Tax Exemption ordinance is available upon request.

Please note that there shall be only one (1) Total Disabled Exemption per qualified parcel.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. The applicant shall be a Town resident who shall own and reside on the real estate where to which the credit is to be applied as of the time of the application for the credit.
2. The applicant shall be a Town resident for a period of not less than five (5) years immediately preceding the application.
3. Person must be 100% disabled and unable to work as of the date of the tax assessment.
4. Must apply on or before April 15th in the year this exemption is to take effect.
5. Must show proof of disability per Social Security Administration.
6. Applicant must apply annually.
